## **Refinery modernization project in Croatia awarded to ABB**

**BLOOMFIELD, NJ, October 17** – ABB Lummus Global has been awarded an EPCM contract by INA Industrija nafte d.d. Zagreb, Croatia, for a hydrocracker/hydrotreater unit at their Rijeka refinery. The integrated unit, based on the ISOCRACKING® process from Chevron Lummus Global, includes amine regeneration and sour water stripper units.

The engineering, procurement, and construction management services will be provided from Lummus's execution center in Brno, Czech Republic. Start-up is scheduled for the second quarter of 2010, which will meet INA's priority to enable production of fuel according to the Euro 5 automotive fuel standards.
